Message from the President...

Please also make sure the fixtures you have are the same as the finalised fixtures posted on the whiteboard at the Rec Centre and on Facebook, they HAVE CHANGED since Grading Night due to additions of new teams and a few minor errors. The last reminder is that uniforms are not to be worn home from the game – to ensure singlets are kept in the best condition possible, please make sure they are returned to the team managers IMMEDIATELY after the game has finished.

Bit of exciting news – recently the Junior and Senior committees had a joint meeting about branding the basketball club to give us a name. It's been decided that we will be named the Waroona Redbacks. We are currently working on creating merchandise for the club such as club shirts, socks etc so watch this space!

22nd/23rd Feb - U/13B, U/14B, U/15B


Coaches will be decided after October $23^{\rm rd}$, and Tryouts will begin after October 30

U/11 Modified Rules

At our recent committee meeting the following modified rules were agreed upon for the Under 11 competition for the 2013/14 season. We would appreciate if coaches and team managers would do their best to assist the junior committee and our referees in enforcing the modified rules.

Please remember the Under 11 competition is designed to be non-competitive and is for our junior players to learn new skills and develop their game. A high percentage (approximately 70%) of our players in this grade are new to the sport and have never played before. The modified rules are being kept closely in line with what is recommended by Basketball WA.

- 1. Teams to play a man on man defence within the three point area only. This will be reassessed at the Christmas break.
- 2. No stealing the ball from players. Intercepts are fine; and
- 3. Lowered rings.

It would be appreciated that coaches work together where possible in matching up their players for the man on man defence according to skill level and height. We know this might be difficult at times but believe it will benefit the players in the long term.

In addition, please note that the Under 11 competition is a platform for our junior referees to learn. Even though they are accompanied by a senior referee they still need to build their skills and confidence. Training referees within our own club is a great asset for our competition in the future so please be patient with them and treat them with respect.
